## Call for Abstracts

### Guidelines for Abstracts:

- The abstracts must not exceed 250 words.
- All abstracts must be typed, single spaced, with a clear typeface.
- Title should be in capitals and underlined, and placed at the top of the abstract.
- Author's name should be in capitals, with the name of the presenter indicated by an asterisk (\*).
- Degrees and positions in departments should not be included, but the origin of the work should be stated.
- The abstract must be clear and brief. Statements should, in general, be impersonal and the first person "I" and "We" avoided.
- The abstracts will be presented at the conference as a Power Point presentation.

The abstract should be organized as follows:-

1. purpose of study
2. a brief statement of methods
3. a summary of the results adequate to support conclusions
4. conclusions
